Program Synopsis

ACORN is an exclusive Far Sight Skills Development offering that works with emerging leaders to develop twelve attributes of exemplary leadership found in a wide range of arenas including politics, corporate life, churches, small businesses and communities. Each module in the program focuses on one of the attributes and uses storytelling, exemplary figures, group work journaling and workshop interactions to help participants grow their leadership skills in their personal and public lives.

The twelve attributes highlighted in the Program are

Passion	Humility
Courage	Proper Use of Authority
Vision	Team Building
Attentiveness	Teaching and Mentoring
Character	Persistent Follow-through
Responsibility	Storytelling

Each module begins with a personal story delivered by the facilitators and then considers the life of exemplary leader figures such as Thuli Madonsela, Nthato Motlana, George Washington Carver, Peter Storey, Mvumi Dandala, Hamilton Nati, Gcina Mhlope, Zyda Rylands, Desiree Ellis and others.

Our discussion of exemplary leaders prompts delegates to ask themselves some private questions which they may journal. Where appropriate, invited speakers add their own perspectives on leadership and motivate participants to take themselves to the next level. Each module closes by asking delegates to define a plan of action that will help them develop the leadership attribute in their own lives.

Delegates take with them a set of module notes and their own journals for future reference.
